

## *Slanted Rib Jacket*

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This dress-up or dress-down jacket is bordered by a ribbed shawl collar that drapes diagonally with the attached ribbed bottom. It looks complicated, but all of the shaping is done in stockinette on the main bed. The ribbed panels are quick and easy rectangles that even a novice on the ribber can manage.



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**Knitting machine:** Standard bed with ribber attachment.

**Yarn:** Viscose Stretch from Silk City

**Gauge:** St. st. at T6: 37 sts and 54 rows = 4 in/10cm;

Ribbing at T6/6: 52 sts and 50 rows = 4 in/10 cm

**Yardage:** 3300/3046 (3600/3323, 4200/3877, 4800/4430)yards/ meters

**Sizes:** Small, (Medium, Large and Extra Large)

**Bust Measurements:** 32-34 in./81-86 cm (36-38 in/91.5-96.5 cm, 40-42 in/101.5-106.5 cm, 44-46 in/111.5=117 cm)

## **BACK**

E-wrap from left to right 128 (150, 162, 176). Place marker at 0 to mark center back. RC000. COR.

T6. Knit 98 (102, 102, 104) rows, increasing one stitch on each side

**Small:** every 7<sup>th</sup> row, 5X; and then every 8<sup>th</sup> row, 7X. 152 sts.

**Medium:** every 10<sup>th</sup> row, 7X; and then every 11<sup>th</sup> row, 2X. 168 sts.

**Large:** every 6<sup>th</sup> row, 13X; and then every 7<sup>th</sup> row, 2X. 192. **Extra**

**Large:** every 8<sup>th</sup> row, 12X. 200 sts.

**Armhole shaping:** B/O 4 (4, 5, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows, and then 2 (2, 3, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. At each side, dec 1 st

**Small:** every 5<sup>th</sup>, 9X. 122 sts. Knit to RC 200.

**Medium:** every 4<sup>th</sup> row, 12X. 132 sts. Knit to RC 210.

**Large:** every 4<sup>th</sup> row, 15X. 146 sts. Knit to RC 216

**Extra Large:** every 4<sup>th</sup> row, 13X. 156 sts. Knit to RC 226

**Short-rowing shoulders:** Place marker at center back. COR. Set carriage to hold and

**Small:** COR. Place last 8 needles on left to hold, K1R, W. Place last 8 needles on right to hold, W, K1R. Repeat last two rows, 3X. Release hold, K1R. COR. B/O 32 shoulder sts on each side and then 58 back neck sts.

**Medium:** COR. Place last 7 needles on left to hold, K1R, W. Place last 7 needles on right to hold, K1R, W. Repeat last two rows, 4X. Release hold, K1R. B/O 35 shoulder sts on each side and 62 back neck sts.

**Large:** COR. Place last 7 needles on left to hold, K1R, W. Place last 7 needles on right to hold, K1R, W. Repeat last two rows, 2X. Place next 8 needles on left to hold, K1R, W. Place next 8 needles on right to hold, K1R, W. Repeat last 2 rows, 1X. Release hold, K1R. COR. B/O 37 shoulder sts on each side and 72 back neck sts.

**Extra Large:** Place last 5 needles on left to hold, K1R, W. COL. Place last 5 needles on right to hold, K1R, W. COR. Place next 6 needles on left to hold, K1R, W. Place next 6 needles on right to hold, K1R, W. Repeat last two rows 4X. Release hold, K1R. COR. B/O

41 shoulder sts on each side and 74 back neck sts.

### **RIGHT UPPER FRONT**

E-wrap C/O 35 (39, 45, 51) sts from right to left.

COL RC000. T6. Knit 98 (102, 102, 104) rows, increasing one stitch on right side

**Small:** every 7th row, 5X; and then every 8<sup>th</sup> row, 7X. 47 sts

**Medium:** every 10th row, 7X; and then every 11<sup>th</sup> row, 2X. 48 sts

**Large:** every 6th row, 13X; and then every 7<sup>th</sup> row, 2X. 60 sts

**Extra Large:** every 6<sup>th</sup> row, 14X; and then every 7<sup>th</sup> row, 2X. 67 sts

**Armhole shaping:** B/O 4 (4, 5, 5), K2R. B/O 2 (2, 3, 4) K2R. At right side, dec 1 st.

**Small:** every 5<sup>th</sup>, 9X. 32 sts, Knit to RC 200.

**Medium:** every 6<sup>th</sup> row, 1X; and then every 7<sup>th</sup> row, 6X. 35 sts. Knit to RC 210

**Large:** every 4th row, 15X. 37 sts. Knit to RC 216

**Extra large:** every 3rd row, 16X; and then every 4<sup>th</sup> row, 1X. 41 sts. Knit to RC 226

**Short-rowing shoulders:** Set carriage to hold. COL

**Small:** Place last 8 needles on right to hold, KWK Repeat last two rows, 3X. Release hold, K1R. B/O 32 shoulder sts.

**Medium:** Place last 7 needles on right to hold, KWK. Repeat last two rows, 4X. Release hold, K1R. B/O 35 shoulder sts.

**Large:** : Place last 7 needles on right to hold, KWK. Repeat last two

rows, 2X. Place next 8 needles on right to hold, KWK. Repeat last two rows 1X. Release hold, K1R. B/O 38 shoulder sts.

**Extra Large:** : Place last 5 needles on right to hold, KWK. Place next 6 needles on right to hold, KWK. Repeat last two rows 5X. Release hold, K1R. B/O 41 shoulder sts.

### **LEFT UPPER FRONT**

Knit as for right upper front, starting with COR and reversing shaping.

**BOTTOM:** Engage ribber. Cast-on 136 (142, 156, 168) sts for 2X2 rib. T6. Knit a total of 586 (634, 678, 722) rows, placing markers on far right side needle at RC 149 (152, 154, 154); RC 293 (317, 339, 361); and RC 437 (482, 524, 568). B/O for 2X2 ribbing.

**SHAWL COLLAR:** Engage ribber. Cast-on 98 (104, 118, 124) sts for 2X2 rib. T6, Knit 754 (778, 796, 828) rows in 2X2 ribbing, placing markers on far right side needle at RC149 (152, 154, 154); RC 377 (389, 398, 414); and RC 605 (626, 642, 674). B/O for 2X2 ribbing.

### **SLEEVES**

COL. C/O with WY, 35 (36, 42, 46) sts on each side of 0. K10R.

**Hem:** K1R with ravel cord. COR. T5, K7R. T7, K1R. T 5, K8R. Hang hem. COL. T6, K1R

**Arm:** COR. RC000. Inc 1 st on each side every 9<sup>th</sup> row, 8X (8X, 2X, 22X) and then every 10<sup>th</sup>, row, 14X (14X, 20X, 2X) 57, (58, 64, 70) sts on each side of 0. RC 212 (212, 218, 218). Knit to RC 222 (222, 228, 228).

**Sleeve Cap shaping:** B/O 4 (4, 5, 5) sts at beg of next two rows, and then 2 (2, 3, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st on each side every 3<sup>rd</sup> row 1X (0X, 1X, 0X ); every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 29X (32X, 31X, 36X ); every 3<sup>rd</sup> row 1X (0X, 1X, 0X ). B/O remaining 40 (40, 46, 50) sts.

**FINISHING:** Steam pieces. Join fronts to back at shoulder and side seams. Join ribbed bottom to bottom of front and back, matching mid-back markers. Leave 11.875in/30cm1 (12.125 inches/31 cm, 12.25 in/31 cm, 12.25/31 cm) extending at each front edge. Sew shawl collar to bottom along selvedge edges so that ribbing lines fall in the same direction, i.e. parallel, and along front edges of fronts, back neck, matching markers as you go. Sew arm seam each sleeve together. Sew sleeve caps to armhole, right side together.

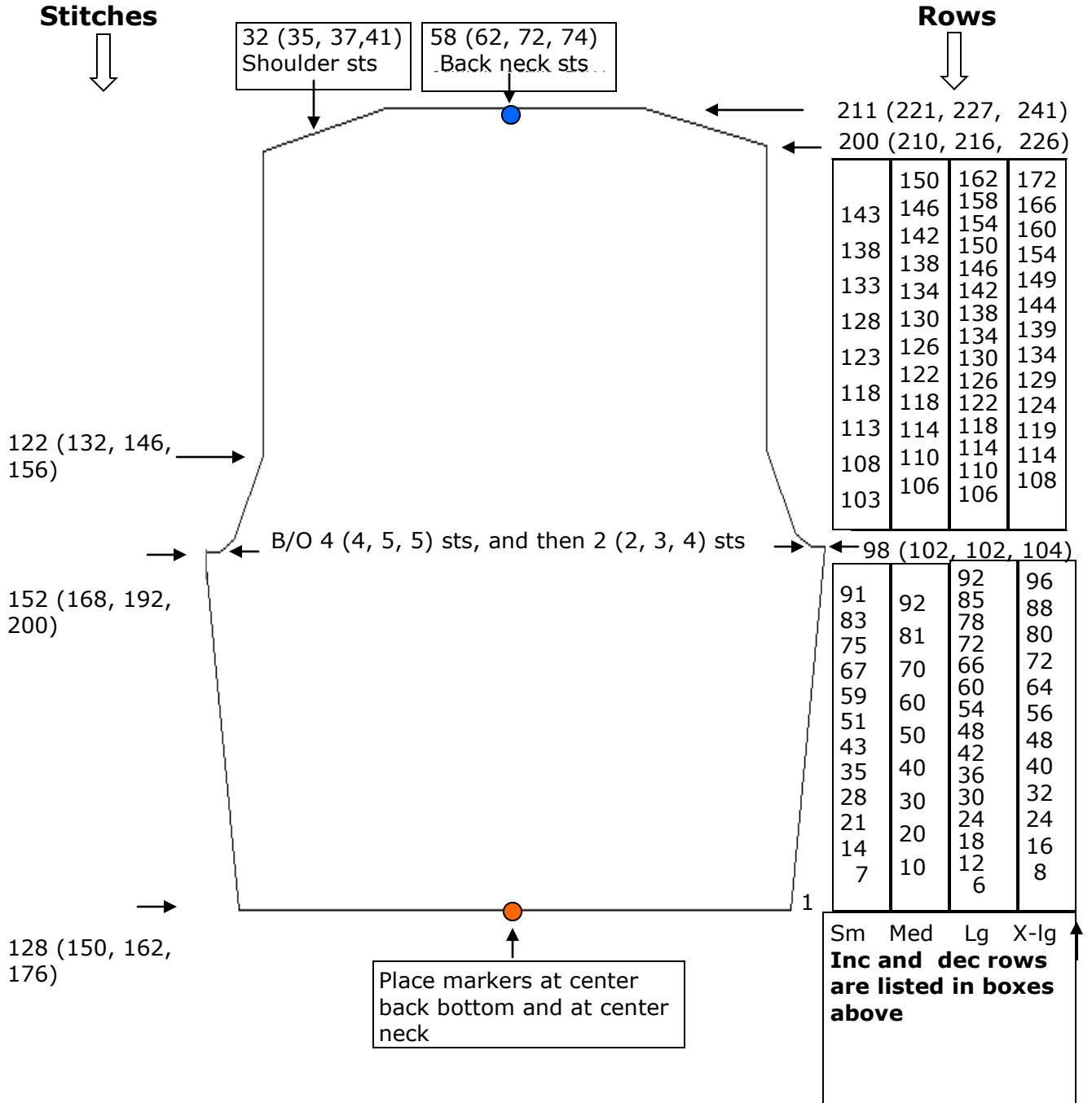

KWK	Knit 1 row, wrap last needle in hold (the needle closest to first needle in B position), knit one row.
RC	row counter
T6	tension 6
W	Wrap last needle in hold (the needle closest to first needle in B position)

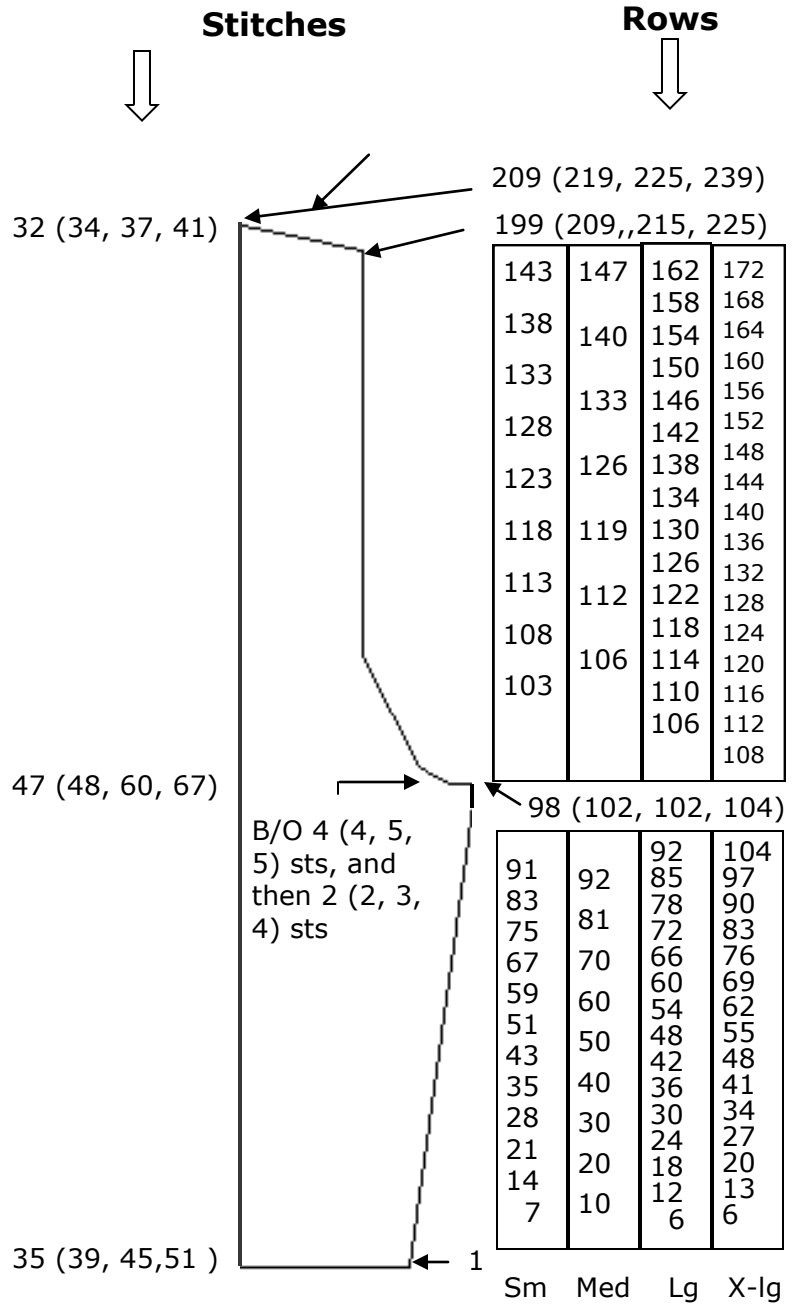

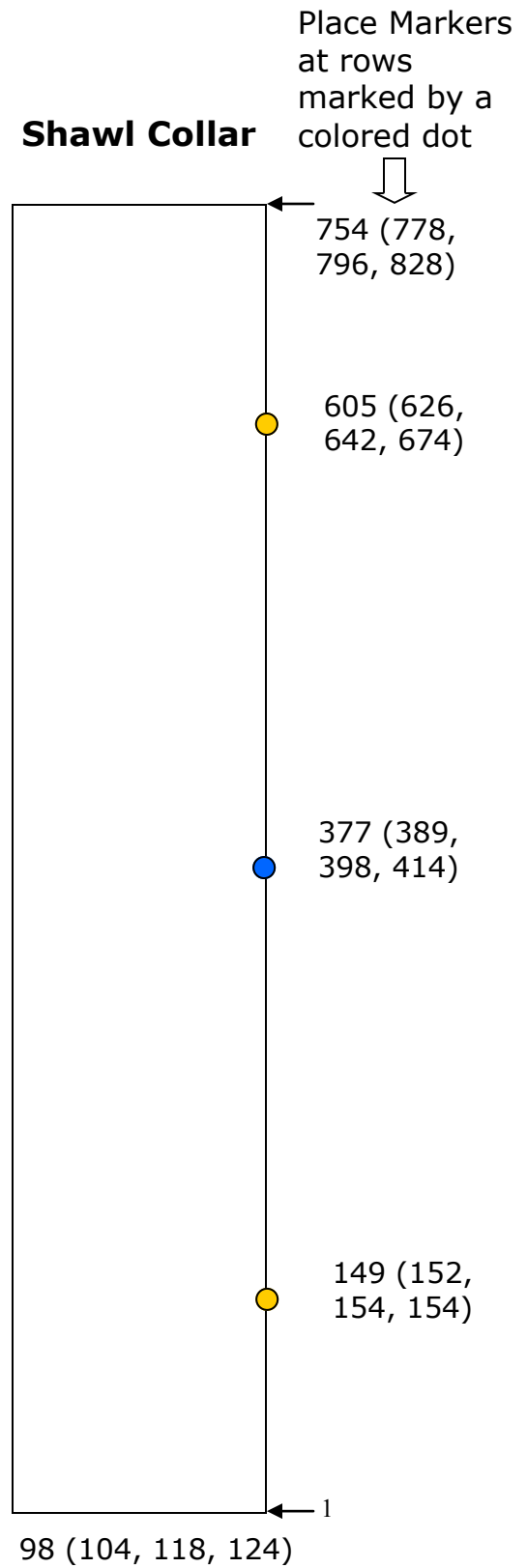
